- Living a "Risk-Oriented" Lifestyle

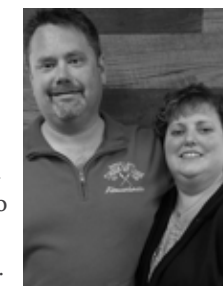
We encourage fellowship and celebrate God's healing power in our lives as we work our way along the road to recovery.
