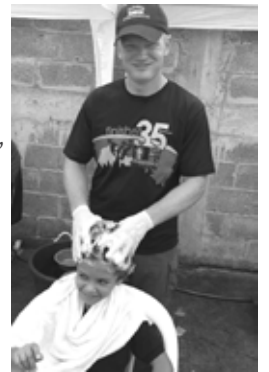

Partnering with an organization called Point of Impact (POI), and equipped with the power of the Holy Spirit, our youth shared scripture and passed out meals at "the dump," coordinated three days of vacation Bible school in gang-controlled neighborhoods, performed lice treatments for almost 100 Honduran youth, purchased and delivered a new refrigerator for a special needs orphanage, and delivered "tubs of love" (three months of food) and shared testimonies to needy families. The sight of our youth sharing personal testimonies of what Jesus is doing in their lives with tear-filled eyes was both moving and inspiring.
