Each participant will leave with a book to help them navigate the river of loss.

If you have lost a spouse, regardless of how many years ago, we encourage you to attend. If you have a friend or a parent who has lost a spouse, we encourage both of you to sign up and attend together. People often say, I wish I knew what I could do to help. This workshop is a valuable resource which will help those who have lost a spouse. We both wish we would have had this resource after we lost our spouses.
